(With the exception of positioning and spacing, the format for footnotes and endnotes is identical. See the MLA Handbook for specific instructions) The MLA Handbook has examples of actual papers, including Works Cited and notes, along with guidelines on how to set them up. Consult with your professor for specific paper requirements.

In the case of certain specific types of references, for which there is no MLA rule or example, the examples given reflect the determinations of the librarians, in conjunction with our faculty.

Helpful Information

In general, omit titles, affiliations and degrees.(Eg: SJ, PhD., Sister, or Saint).
Jr. or a Roman Numeral appears after the given name, preceded by a comma.

To cite two or more books by the same author, give the names in the first entry
only. Thereafter, in place of the names, type three hyphens, followed by a period
and the title.
