COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

CL836D: Canon Law for the Diaconate - Canonical Aspects of the Church's Sanctifying Mission (3 credits)

This course reviews the theological foundation of Church Law in regards to the needs for the deacon. It will focus upon aspects of ministry within the parish inclusive of the sacraments. There will be a focus on annulments, clerical rights, dispensations in marriage and their meaning. There will also be a review of practical cases that will apply what is learned.

HT525: General Church History (3 credits)
